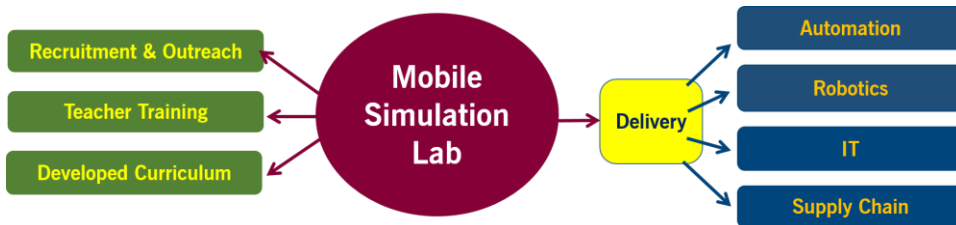

- 100% of teachers will receive professional development (PD) and instructional support.
